### **Reports**

#### ❖ **Administrator's Report - John Engelbrecht:**

- Calvary has received two gift donations totaling about \$67,000 to be used for the baseball field, concession stand and a storage building.
- Next Thursday is the Business Expo at the YMCA Firley Center. Mrs. Luetkemeyer and some of her students will have a Calvary booth there.
- Calvary's Gift recently had a jewelry sale which brought in \$1,000 that day and \$2,000 for the week. The second anniversary for Calvary's Gift will be November 2<sup>nd</sup>. \$90,000 has been given back to the school so far. Students from the Spanish class have been making phone calls to thank individuals who volunteer their time to work at Calvary's Gift. Different ways to thank volunteers was discussed. Several agreed it was a good idea to always remember to thank the volunteers and also bringing small treats to them while working.
- A Calvary sign for the school is on the way. This will be a granite sign with engraving. No LED lighting is allowed on the sign due to our location. Have \$4,500 in costs that is not covered that the cookbook could possibly fund.

#### ❖ **Treasurer's Report & Projected Budget Sheet by Denise Crider:**

- The Treasurer Report of year-to-date income and expenses & checking account balance as of September 26, 2011 was reviewed. A motion was made by Alison Jenkins with Debra Johnson seconding to approve Treasurer's report. The motion was approved.
- The Projected Working Budget Sheet was distributed and reviewed. The Apple Sale has no projected income since this will not take place this year due to crop issues. Will add Volleyball admission of approximately \$750 and concession stand of \$350 to this list. We have \$7,000 listed for a Calvary sign that proceeds from the cookbook might be able to cover the cost of some of this. The Cookbook proceeds will be revisited at a later date. A motion was made by Alison Jenkins with Teresa White seconding to approve the Budget Sheet. The motion was approved.
- Denise passed out and discussed the Booster Apparel and Charm Inventory list. This inventory will be sold at the BBQ at Schulte's in October.

6. Athletic - Tammy will ask Marvin Bernskoetter if he would be willing to chair this once again.

- School Climate & Social Activities: Red Ribbon week will begin on 10/24 and the theme will be “Barn Warming” and will end with a fall dance and lock-in on 10/28. We will need red and white tablecloths, treats, and chaperons for this event. Holly indicated she could provide about 10 tablecloths. There will not be admission for the dance but will charge \$5 for the lock-in that will take place from 10pm-1am.
- Fundraising: BBQ will take place at Schulte’s on October 8<sup>th</sup> to raise funds for athletic needs. Jan MacLaughlin has made tickets for pre-sale that are available at the school.
- Recognition: Parent/Teacher conferences will take place on October 17<sup>th</sup> from 4-7 pm. Holly will coordinate bringing finger foods to this event with her committee. The next events this committee will coordinate will be on January 2<sup>nd</sup> and March 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Cookbook Update:** Shirley Bernskoetter indicated the cookbook shipment should arrive in November. The cookbooks will come in a 3-ring binder which should have cost us \$2,500 (\$1 per cookbook) but the company gave to us at no cost. Art work by the students is throughout the cookbook and the front cover is artwork by a previous student. We will need students to unload the trucks when these are delivered. It would be a good idea to contact the News Tribune on delivery day for a picture in the paper. The exact cost is still being discussed but will probably sell each book for \$20. This cookbook has the potential of profiting \$20,000.

**Council on Drug Free Youth:** Holly discussed the possibility of offering the Council on Drug Free Youth to speak to the parents at a future boosters meeting. Denise Crider indicated the students are offered this at school. Holly stated they also offer counseling for parents on what to look for, how to handle, and getting parents on the same page of keeping our students safe. Mr. Ahlers agreed this would be great to offer to our parents.

**Booster Meeting Dates:** It was discussed and agreed that booster meetings will take place on the third Monday of each month beginning at 5:30 p.m. and would not be cancelled due to sporting events. A motion was made by Teresa White with Danielle Rakow seconding to approve the meetings dates. The motion was approved.
