Reports

❖ **Treasurer's Report & Working Budget Sheet by Denise Crider:**

- The Treasurer Report of year-to-date income and expenses & checking account balance as of December 11, 2011 was reviewed.
- The Projected Working Budget Sheet was distributed and reviewed.
- Denise Crider indicated we have almost sold enough cookbooks to cover the costs and money is still coming in.
- We are still trying to track down a couple of missing uniforms from softball and baseball. Denise Sommerer will be touching up the baseball uniforms before next season.

❖ **Administrator's Report - John Engelbrecht:**

- John stated work on the baseball field has begun and fencing and foul poles are being installed. Gary Oberkrum is working on the details for this project as we move forward. The field should be complete before the spring season begins.

❖ **Committee Reports – Committee members, progress, activities, ect.:**

- Recognition
 1. Calvary staff received a cookbook and Calvary shirt for Christmas gifts this season.
 2. The next Parent/Teacher conference will take place on Monday, January 2nd.
- Athletic
 1. The 2nd annual girls and boys basketball tournament will take place on January 6-7th at Trinity and Helias gyms. Sixteen teams will participate in the tournament and will also include a Three Point Contest. Help from all parents is needed for this event as well as donations to maximize our profits in concessions.
 2. The Booster Committee is asking parents to donate 12 packs of soda when they come to parent/teacher conferences for the tournament. A donation list will be assigned for each athletic student and emailed to all to simplify the process. A table will be set up at Parent/Teacher conferences to sign up to donate last minute items needed at the tournament (pies, buns, drinks).
- Public Relations – The Calvary Web Site has had some recent updates. There will be a “Survive and Thrive” open house for prospective freshman on January 12th. New items have been added by the students and for Athletics at the following location: <http://www.calvarylhs.org/news/>
- Fundraising – Tammy suggested having singing telegrams around Valentine's Day with the delivery of a cookbook also to increase sales of cookbooks and to raise funds for choir events. It was agreed this would be discussed at a later date.

Basketball Tournament: The Athletic Committee had a meeting last week to work out details needed for the upcoming tournament on January 6th and 7th. The following items were discussed and agreed upon at the Booster meeting:

1. Will need all 40 plus athletic families at Calvary to be assigned work slots (3 people per time slot). Will also ask congregations and other Calvary families to assist by email.
2. Tricia will forward John the information on the tournament so he can forward to all bulletin contacts.
3. Calvary students will assist as follows: Kim Ousley will work with Kevin on student volunteers needed. Trevor Dusheke & James Bernskoetter will organize students to pray before each game (Pastors will pray at each gym for opening games and Holly will organize). Students will also find someone to sing the National Anthem at each gym for the beginning game.
4. Will need to find someone to take care of the hospitality room for the refs during the games. Will ask Debra Johnson if can assist in this area. Tammy White will check her calendar and get back to us.
5. Have volunteers as follows: Keith Ousley (Trinity scoreboard), Dawn Jackson (tournament book @ Trinity location), Danielle Rakow (books or clock). Pam Browner will be main contact at Helias location. Will also call Jim Dunkman, Mike Scheperle, Blake Monson and Charlie Oberkrom about assisting with clocks or other areas.
6. Need to clarify with Trinity 5th grade teachers if their rooms can be used for changing rooms or ask about using the Youth Room.
7. Agreed to make hamburgers before the tournament due to space issues and keep in rosters. John indicated he may be able to help make some of the hamburgers.
8. Locker rooms will need to be vacated by each team at half time. Holly will make signs to hang to remind teams about this and Kevin will email the coaches also.
9. Admission will remain the same but will remove the \$10 per family price. Tricia will purchase two different hand stamps (different color per day).
10. Kevin will need to purchase two different scorebooks so one can be used as the official tournament book.
11. Tricia and Denise will work on a contact list of cell numbers and laminate to provide to main contacts the day of tournament.
12. Will need several coolers to store drinks in. Drinks can also be placed outside to stay cold.
13. Denise Crider will check to see if we can get the fruit donated. She will also pick up some supplies we need from Sam's Club.
14. The following menu was agreed upon for the tournament and will also be placed on our website along with other tournament information:
