Here are the standing committees for the CLHS Booster Association:

· ***Academic & Student Organization Support Committee*** – supports the general academic program, student council, & service/leadership group by providing connections to community resources such as guest speakers, promoting school/community/business partnerships, assisting with student organization activities if requested & other actions as needed throughout the year. One member will participate on the school's curriculum committee & reports to the Booster Association. Budgeted activities include field trips, Heit's Pont Retreat & Red Ribbon Week.

· ***Athletic Committee*** – supports the athletic program by assisting with concession stands, gate admissions, uniform care (collecting uniforms after game, washing, & returning to school), fundraising for athletic needs, providing input on athletic programs, & other actions as needed throughout the year. Budgeted activities include a summer sports BBQ & homecoming activities.

· ***Public Relations Committee*** - assists with the promotion of events & activities sponsored by the Booster Association, in cooperation with the school's public relations committee. One member attends the school public relations meetings to share Booster Association activities & then reports to the Booster Association on overall public relations efforts. Budgeted activities include the Jefferson City and Holts Summit Christmas parade.

· ***Fundraising Committee*** – assists with Booster Association fundraising & provides input on types & scheduling of approved fundraising activities. At least one member participates in the school fundraising committee. This member will serve as a liaison between the groups, provides input on fundraising schedules, & assists with other activities as needed. Budgeted items include the fall apple sale, spring plant sale, Dining out with Calvary fundraisers, & coordination of Moser's receipts.

· ***School Climate & Social Activities Committee*** – assists with providing opportunities for positive & encouraging activities to increase school pride & positive interpersonal relationships among students, faculty, parents, churches, & the community at large. A parent from each class (freshman, sophomore, junior and senior) is needed on this committee. Budgeted activities include a fall hayride (to be combined with Red Ribbon week this year) , spring dance, project prom, hospitality at Christmas and spring concerts, & a graduation sub-committee works on the graduation, Senior DVD, graduation reception.

· ***Recognition Committee*** – provides support for activities that recognize outstanding achievement by students & staff. Budgeted activities include end of the year banquet, teacher appreciation efforts, staff gifts, & monthly birthday celebrations (currently the Booster Club is providing soda & tableware with Kathy Irwin providing cake & ice cream for birthdays).
