The focus of the CLHS Booster Association is to provide Christ centered support for current and future betterment of Calvary Lutheran High School. In cooperation with school administrators, the CLHS Booster Association provides input, vision, and leadership for opportunities connected with the school. Input and involvement may include, but is not limited to, the following areas:

- Support of programs (academic, athletic, intra and extra curricular)
- Recognition of student and staff achievement
- Recruitment
- Fundraising
- Public relations efforts
- School climate and social activities

As the parent of a student of Calvary you are a member of the CLHS Booster. CLHS Booster meetings are held the third Monday of each month. Please consider attending the meetings and participating in one of the committees described below.

Academic & Student Organization Support Committee – supports the general academic program, student council, and service/leadership group by providing connections to community resources such as guest speakers, promoting school/community/business partnerships, assisting with student organization activities if requested and other actions as needed throughout the year. One member will participate on the school's curriculum committee and reports to the CLHS Booster. Budgeted activities include field trips, Heit's Point Retreat, and Red Ribbon Week.

Athletic Committee: This committee supports the athletic program by assisting with concession stands, gate admissions, uniform care (collecting uniforms after games, washing and returning to school), fundraising for athletic needs, providing input on athletic programs, and other actions as needed throughout the year. Budgeted activities include two BBQs and homecoming activities.

Public Relations Committee – assists with the promotion of events and activities sponsored by the CLHS Booster, in cooperation with the school's public relations committee. One member attends the school public relations meetings to share CLHS Booster activities and reports to the CLHS Booster on overall public relations efforts. Budgeted activities include the Jefferson City Christmas parade.

Fundraising Committee – assists with CLHS Booster fundraising and provides input on types and scheduling of approved fundraising activities. At least one member participates in the school fundraising committee. This member will serve as a liaison between the groups, provides input on fundraising schedules, and assists with other activities as needed. Budgeted items include the fall apple sale, Mother's Day Flower Sale, Dining Out With Calvary, and coordination of Moser's receipts.

School Climate & Social Activities Committee – assists with providing opportunities for quality activities to increase school pride and positive interpersonal relationships among students, faculty, parents, churches, and the community at large. Class representatives are automatically appointed to this committee. Budgeted activities include a fall hayride, spring dance, project prom, hospitality at concerts, and the graduation reception.

Recognition Committee – provides support for activities that recognize outstanding achievement by students and staff. Budgeted activities include end of the year banquet, teacher appreciation efforts, staff gifts, and monthly birthday celebrations.
