WHAT IF IT SNOWS? - Calvary Lutheran High School does not automatically follow the public school bad weather cancellation protocol. In case of cancellation or late school starts, please tune into TV stations 8, 13, or 17 or radio stations: KWOS 950AM, KATI 94.3FM, KCLR 99.3FM, Y107 106.9FM, KCMQ 96.7FM. When possible, we may use late starts to prevent the loss of too many full days of class. In the event of bad weather, students should exercise caution and common sense. If parents are concerned about the safety of traveling, students should stay home until road conditions allow safe passage. 1. Login to your RenWeb account.
2. On the left-hand side, under School Information, select “Web Forms”
3. In the main section of the screen, select “Family Demographic Form”
4. Select “Student Demographic Form” and “Custodial Parent Form” and verify the information is correct.
5. Please enter an email address so you and your student can login to RenWeb and receive emails.
6. When finished, click “Save” at the bottom of the form.
