**WHAT IF IT SNOWS?** - Calvary Lutheran High School has our own bad weather cancellation protocol. In case of cancellation or late school starts, please tune into TV stations 8, 13, or 17 or radio stations: KWOS 950AM, KATI 94.3FM, KCLR 99.3FM, Y107 106.9FM, KCMQ 96.7FM. When possible, we may use late starts to prevent the loss of too many full days of class. In the event of bad weather, students should exercise caution and common sense. If parents are concerned about the safety of traveling, students should stay home until road conditions allow safe passage. Parents please call to inform us when students are going to be late or absent. RenWeb will be used to contact families by text and phone in the case of cancellations. #### TO CHECK RENWEB CONTACT INFORMATION:

1. Login to your RenWeb account.
2. On the left-hand side, under School Information, select "Web Forms"
3. In the main section of the screen, select "Family Demographic Form"
4. Select "Student Demographic Form" and "Custodial Parent Form" and verify all family and student email addresses and cell phone numbers are correct.
5. Be sure to scroll to the bottom and choose "YES" for Parent Alert: Cell Phone AND choose "NO" for Parent Alert: No Text.
6. When finished, click "Save" at the bottom of each form.
