

Expectations for Prom 2019

- If you and/or your guest leave the premises at any time, you will NOT be permitted to re-enter.
- If you and/or your guest need to go to your vehicle, you must be accompanied by a chaperone.
- Dress code will be followed the entire event.
- Decorations should not be tampered with.
- Leave the facility nicer than when you arrived.
- Food or drink may not be brought to our event. A complete meal will be provided.
- Those leaving the event before the event's end must check out with the organizer.

Dress Code Guidelines

Dress code guidelines for her

- Formal gowns
- No miniskirts, visible cleavage, bare midriffs, or two-piece dresses
- Strapless or spaghetti strap dresses are acceptable.
- Skirt or dress must extend below the fingertips when arms are extended at side.
- Bare or open backs are **NOT** acceptable. Back line must above normal bra line.
- No flesh-colored or see-through fabric over areas supposed to be covered with material
- Dress shoes or sandals **MUST** be worn the entire time. Please make sure they are comfortable.
- No athletic shoes or sneakers
- Undergarments must be worn but not visible.
- See-through apparel/gowns or dresses with slits above the mid-thigh area are **NOT** acceptable.
- We ask that you bring a nice sweater or shawl to use in case it is needed in the course of the evening, or if in the judgment of the adult chaperones, the dress is viewed as immodest.

Dress code guidelines for him

- Dress shirt and tie, dress pants, and belt are required; tuxedos are acceptable.
- Dress shoes must be worn the entire time.
- No athletic shoes or sneakers
- No earrings
- No clashing of colors to make yourself stand out
- Calvary students must be clean shaven.
- Shirts and ties must be worn at all times.

If you or your guest is not able or willing to remedy a dress code infraction, be aware that your parent(s) and/or guardian(s) will be contacted by faculty or staff, and you will be asked to leave.

Expectations for Project Prom 2019

Project Prom will immediately follow prom. The event will last from 11 p.m. to 3 a.m., at Calvary. This event is designed to offer a safe fellowship opportunity. Admission cost is included in the prom fee. For those not attending prom, admission is \$5.00.

- Students are expected to go **immediately** from the site of prom to the site of project prom. If a student needs to make other arrangements due to transportation issues, that student needs to work out those arrangements with the project prom organizer **before** the date of prom.
- If you and/or your guest leave the premises at any time, you will **NOT** be permitted to re-enter.
- If you and/or your guest need to go to your vehicle, you must be accompanied by a chaperone.
- Dress code for project prom is informal. T-shirts and shorts may be worn. Shirts must not have inappropriate messages on them. Shorts must be modest.
- Food or drink may not be brought to our event. These will be provided.
- Guests who attend prom may come to project prom.
- Those leaving the event before the event's end must check out with the organizer.
- The parent/guardians of those student and/or guests who leave early will be contacted by the organizer.
