FAITH MISSION TRIP OPPORTUNITIES - Faith Lutheran Church will once again be sponsoring 2 mission trips. Calvary students, families and staff are invited to be a part of these awesome opportunities "to go and make disciples of all nations..."

The 2 trips are as follows:

- * Panama City, Panama June 21-28, 2020 (English as a second language training)
