### CALVARY INSIDER – What has been happening at Calvary?

• To open our 16th academic year, Virtual Opening Worship was led by Pastor Diener. We were thrilled to celebrate with this annual time to worship and thank God for blessing Calvary and all who are touched by this place; • Back to School Night was a huge success! Students were able to prepare lockers, turn in forms, meet faculty, and pick up Calvary spirit wear. It was great to see so many parents and students on campus!; • 2019-2020 yearbooks are hot off the press and students were excited to pick them up and walk down member lane!; • Many new precautions have been taken to keep our students and faculty as safe and healthy as possible. Hand sanitizers have been added outside every classroom, polycarbonate dividers have been added to classroom and café tables, and face masks are being worn when necessary; • Mr. Christman led our opening chapel service on the first day of school celebrating our theme verse – “speak HIS truth” Colossians 4:3

**FACE MASK THANK YOU’S** - As much as we may not enjoy wearing them, THANK YOU to all Calvary families for furnishing face masks for your student. This week went extremely well and students and faculty adjusted to our “new normal.” Please be sure to wash face masks frequently and have multiple available for your student during the week.

**NEW NEWS!...FALL ATHLETE NECK GAITORS** - Per the recommendation from MSHSAA, all Missouri high school athletes will be required to wear protective face masks/neck gaitors. These items are required to match as a part of our team uniforms. We have team neck gaitors in and ask that **all baseball, cross country, and volleyball athletes and managers purchase these “neck gaitors” for \$5 right away from the school office.** These will need to be worn for the first competitions happening next week. **FAMILY GROUPS** – Initially inspired by former Calvary students wanting to keep the tight-knit family feel from our early years, our program called “Family Groups” was created. On the first day of school, students are placed in a Family Group led by a faculty advisor and stay in that “family” through graduation. This is a way for students to meet others they might not otherwise know. They sit together in chapel to worship, occasionally eat lunch together, and participate in school activities together.
