**Early Dismissal Reminders** - As fall sports are in full swing and more activities are gearing up, here is a reminder of student responsibilities when they are dismissed early. This procedure is for ALL co-curricular activity early releases. If the student misses LESS THAN 2 class periods, no form needs to be filled out. If the student misses MORE THAN 2 class periods (even a few minutes of the third hour), the student must pick up a *Planned Absence Form* from the office or their coach and get all missed and assignments from teachers. It is good practice to communicate with teachers when missing any class periods.
