FINAL EXAM EXEMPTIONS – At Calvary, students that have shown a level of excellence in attendance, attitude, and academics may qualify for exam exemptions. This is a earned privilege. If students have no more than two tardies, no more than three absences, and have earned a 90% or above in a class, they may qualify to be exempt from the exam in that class. Half of the exemptions earned can be redeemed (rounding up in the case of an odd number), allowing them to not take the final exams in the classes they choose to redeem exemptions for. Exemptions may not be earned in classes being taken for college credit.

- Calvary lunch program will NOT be ordered during finals (December 19 & 20).
- · Calvary Dress Code applies as normal.
- · No finals can be taken early.
- Any missed finals must be taken before Christmas. Make arrangements with Mr. Ahlers.
