FAITH MISSION TRIP OPPORTUNITIES - Faith Lutheran Church will once again be sponsoring 2 mission trips. Calvary students, families and staff are invited to be a part of these awesome opportunities “to go and make disciples of all nations...”

The 2 trips are as follows:

- * Panama City, Panama - June 21-28, 2020 (English as a second language training)
- * Jinotega, Nicaragua - July 18-25, 2020 (House Build, VBS, Evangelism)

The cost for the trips are set at \$1500 per person with the possibility of that cost going down based on number of participants, travel costs, and any additional fund raising done.
